

Wildlife Wednesdays this winter at John Ball Zoo

Join the staff and volunteers of John Ball Zoo this winter for a wildlife encounter on the third Wednesdays of February and March. These programs are great for all ages, whether you are an adult coming by yourself or if you want to bring the whole family. We'll present multiple animals for up-close viewing and include hands-on activities throughout each program. We hope to see you at the zoo!

Dates & Programs:

February 3rd - *Rulers of the Sky* - Some rule by day and some rule by night. Raptors are magnificent creatures admired for their strength and beauty. Get an up close view of some of nature's incredible feathered hunters.

February 17th - *Animal Survivor* – Camouflage, “weapons”, food, shelter...living in Nature is challenging, even for the animals. We will explore the animals' survival techniques and look further to find ways we can help.

March 3rd - *Feeding Frenzy* – What does a monkey munch or a snake swallow? We will learn how animals are adapted for getting and eating specific foods in the wild, investigate predator/prey relationships and see special foods our zoo animals eat to stay healthy.

March 17th – *Go “Green” for Wildlife* – Join us on St. Patrick's Day to learn what you can do to be “green” and support the wildlife that live in your backyard. We'll get to know some of our local animals and learn how to share your backyard space. Learn what the zoo does to take care of our animals and how you can be a “green” nature neighbor.
