Cleaning & Maintaining exhibits

*(Scrubbing habitat, cleaning viewing windows & vacuuming substrate)*

Preparing food for feeding &  
feeding exhibit animals

Cleaning & maintaining work area,  
dive gear and related equipment

Assisting with moving of animals or other  
on-going projects with Aquarist, as needed



## YOU MUST BE:

- 21 Years of Age
- Nationally recognized SCUBA certified, with at least 15 logged dives
- Able to lift 50 pounds
- Fit for diving as stated in a written statement from a physician
- Strongly interested in diving, learning & teaching!
- Able to commit to volunteering one weekday shift, 1-4 PM, every other week

## NEEDED:

- Ability to follow instructions of staff
- Ability to work with minimum supervision
- Ability to dive in a manner that does not adversely affect the exhibit or the animals contained in it.
